Clemency (reduction in sentence)

Criteria:

- Serving a federal sentence;
- Serving a sentence that, if imposed today, would be substantially shorter;
- Have a non-violent history with no significant ties to organized crime, gangs or cartels;
- Have served at least 10 years;
- · Have no significant prior convictions; and
- Have demonstrated good conduct in prison.

- ✓ Current CJA panel member are exempt from training
- ✓ Complete the survey
- ✓ Evaluate an applicant under the above criteria.
